

GENERAL WEBSITE - TERMS OF USE

The website located at architeam.net.au (the **Site**) is operated by ArchiTeam Cooperative Ltd (ABN 65 894 162 886) (**ArchiTeam, us, we, our**). References in this document to 'you' or 'your' refer to any user of this Site.

Your access to and use of the Site and the data it contains (collectively, your **Access**) is conditional on your acceptance and compliance with the terms contained on this page (**Terms of Use**).

By using the Site or the services, goods, features or functionality offered through the Site (**Services**) you agree to be bound by these Terms of Use. Additionally, our specific terms (for example, terms relating to membership or events) may also apply to you, depending how you engage with us.

Eligibility to use our Site

1. Our Site is directed to users who are residing in and using the Site within Australia.

Privacy

2. By accepting these Terms of Use you agree to the collection, use and sharing of information in accordance with the ArchiTeam <u>Privacy Policy</u>.

Ownership of content

- 3. - 7. You agree that you will not:
